

What is the ADAMHS Board?

The ADAMHS Board is a division of the County Governments of Tuscarawas and Carroll Counties and is managed by an eighteen member volunteer Board of Directors. The ADAMHS Board is committed to ensuring that the mental health and substance abuse treatment and prevention needs of our residents experiencing these disorders are met in the most efficient, economic and clinically effective manner possible. The Board carries out its mission by providing financial assistance to support the cost of behavioral services at local, state certified mental health and substance abuse treatment agencies. A network of 53 ADAMHS Boards engages in community planning, system financing and monitoring of this "Safety Net" of community services on behalf of all of Ohio's 88 Counties.

Am I eligible for benefits from the ADAMHS Board system of care?

The **ADAMHS Board** system of care offers individuals and families various types of financial assistance for mental health and substance abuse services. Some examples are as follows:

Partial and Full Coverage. A variety of treatment services provided at behavioral health agencies are partially or fully subsidized by the ADAMHS Board. This includes services for individuals and families unable to pay for services or with limited third party or other insurance benefits.

Sliding Fee Scale: All local agencies contracting with the **ADAMHS Board** calculate consumer costs on a system-wide sliding fee scale based on income and family size. For example, a family of four (4) with a monthly income of \$3,410 would be required to pay \$70 of a \$100 service. The remaining \$30 would be subsidized by the **ADAMHS Board**. (This is an example and does not include various additional factors which could change the sliding fee percentage.)

Medicaid: Medicaid is a federal entitlement program for eligible individuals and families with low incomes and resources. The federal government pays for 60% of the service cost and the **ADAMHS Board** provides the remaining 40%.

Insurance: Many insurance plans include coverage for some services provided by our local mental health and substance abuse agencies.
